\* Where the amount of attested 20 Hours ECE hours at Tawa Montessori Preschool is less than the amount listed, the standard fee will apply for the difference in hours.

**Please note:**

- A three (3) week advance fee payment may be required when enrolling. This advance payment is credited upon starting or refunded if the enrolment is cancelled at least one month prior to the agreed start date.
- A sibling discount of 5% applies to the second child of the same family who attends the same number of sessions or less, simultaneously.
- An invoice will be sent to families covering the entire terms fees. These must be paid at least weekly in advance. Fees/Charges are applicable during absences (i.e. illness, vacations), teacher only days (maximum 2 per year), temporary closure beyond our control (i.e. pandemic, extreme weather conditions) and statutory holidays.
- The preschool is open during school holidays but fees are only charged if you attend. Non-attendance in these periods still counts towards funding absence limits.
- All accounts for the school year are to be settled in full on the last school day of the calendar year and when the child leaves.
- Our fee structure reflects our commitment to provide a high quality authentic Montessori education and a quality enviro-nature programme. We offer free 20 Hours ECE for three, four and five year olds. Fees are applicable for any hours not covered by the 20 Hours ECE. Children enrolled with 20 Hours ECE and attending less than 20 hours are asked to pay an optional charge instead of fees. The optional charge contributes to costs related to the provision of: Montessori curriculum, programme and equipment, Teacher ratio exceeding Ministry of Education requirements, Montessori trained Teachers and Professional Development, Enviro-Nature programme and Animals programme, additional childhood programme providers such as Music Class and most excursions or field trips.
